REPORT FROM JOHN HEGENBARTH

Hello family and friends,

I wanted to take this opportunity to report on our trip to the Philippines from April 1 thru April 15, 2010. First though, I want to thank everyone again for the financial and prayer support. The positive results from this trip will be rewarded for eternity to all who shared in the work in any way.



Pastor Fubara and I arrived April 2, 2010 at about 10:30 PM in Manila, Philippines. We were met by friends and 2 people from Nigeria, who are on staff for Living Gospel Ministries in Port Harcourt, Nigeria. Pastor Akeem, and protocol supervisor, Sophia Adeh, were of tremendous help and support in all of the meetings. The entire crusade and meetings were hosted by House at Bethany Church, along with Pastors King and Eunice

Advincula. Also, working hand in hand were dozens of other churches and ministries. Together, I was so impressed and amazed at the amount of hard work, prayer, and unity among all of those who participated in San Jose city.

Sunday was Easter, and we all shared a little at church. The next day, Monday, the local churches and ourselves, put together a convoy of vehicles, and with a public address system, drove through many parts of the city of San Jose. One pastor continually announced the upcoming crusade. That night, over 350 people came, including the city mayor, who spoke encouraging words to all those present. Pastor Fubara preached the beginning of a 3 part message entitled, "The Incorruptible Seed". Most of the



people came forward for prayer for one thing or another. Many received Christ as their Lord and Saviour. The next day, Tuesday, we had the first of 2 meetings for the pastors and leaders. That night, over 400 people came to the crusade. Among salvations, several healings were testified of and confirmed. Among them, was an amazing one. A woman, was numb, and had no feeling in her right leg. After prayer, she was fully healed. The next day, Wednesday, we held the second Pastors and leaders meeting. The

Eunivie Princess accomplished studies in the field of nursing. I noted that this family has given their entire lives to serving people. From full time ministry in training young men and women to becoming Pastors and teachers, to working with so many churches in northern Philippines, to attending, and graduating 4 years of nursing school.
